Dear Indiana Chapter,

The NCRS Foundation appreciates your Chapters donation in the amount of \$500.00. By contributing to the NCRS Foundation you are enabling us to expand the support of the NCRS Scholarship program. As we continue to grow the NCRS Foundation, we have been able to increase the number of scholarships being awarded as well as increasing the value of the scholarships.

Due to yours and others generosity we have awarded scholarships for 15 years. With the finalization of the selection process in September of this year, we once again awarded Scholarships for the 2023-2024 School Year in the amount of \$26,000. We once again awarded 12 General scholarships with 2 being utilized for an automotive-related candidates meeting all the requirements, the Donald Majestic Memorial Scholarship, the Marvin Burnett Memorial Education Scholarship as well as the Gilbert Scrivner Memorial Scholarship to the overall top applicant. In addition, the Nebraska chapter continues the annual Terrance Breher Memorial Scholarship which follows all the requirements of the scholarship program but will be granted to a qualified applicant sponsored by a current Nebraska Chapter member or another student if no eligible candidates from Nebraska.

Since we began awarding scholarships in 2009, the Foundation has been able to continue to increase both the number and the value of the scholarships due to the generosity of its members to pay it forward. In the past 15 years we have awarded 193 scholarships totaling \$297,500.
