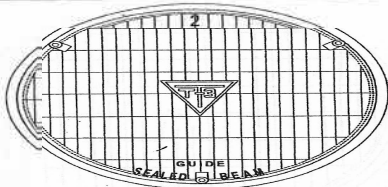

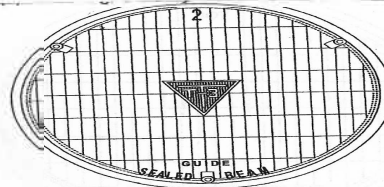

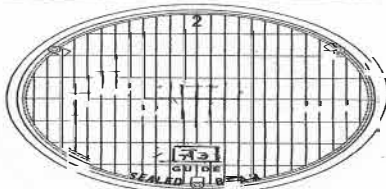

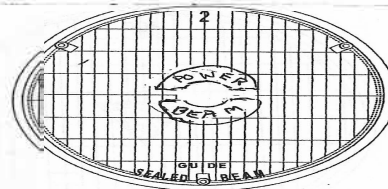

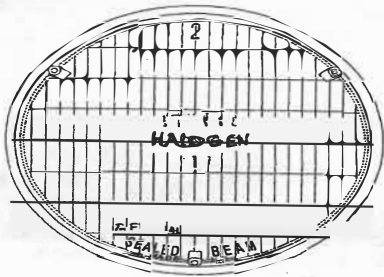

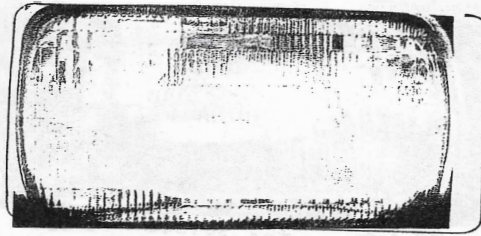

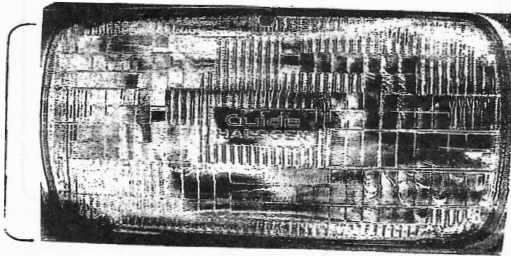

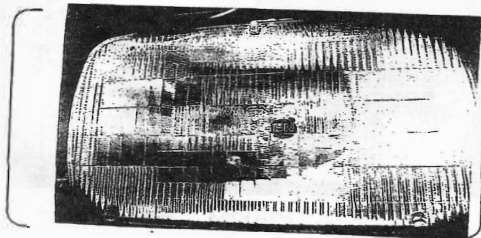

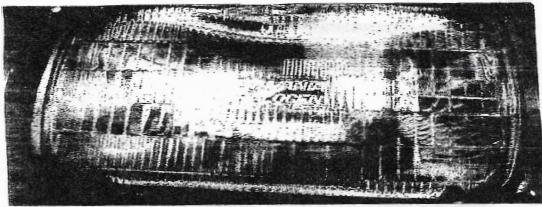

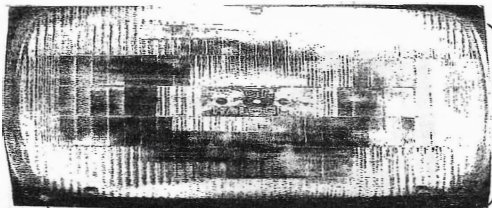

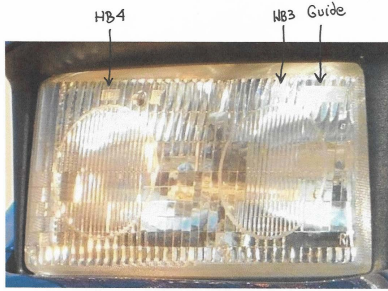


93 Sylvania Plastic Lens

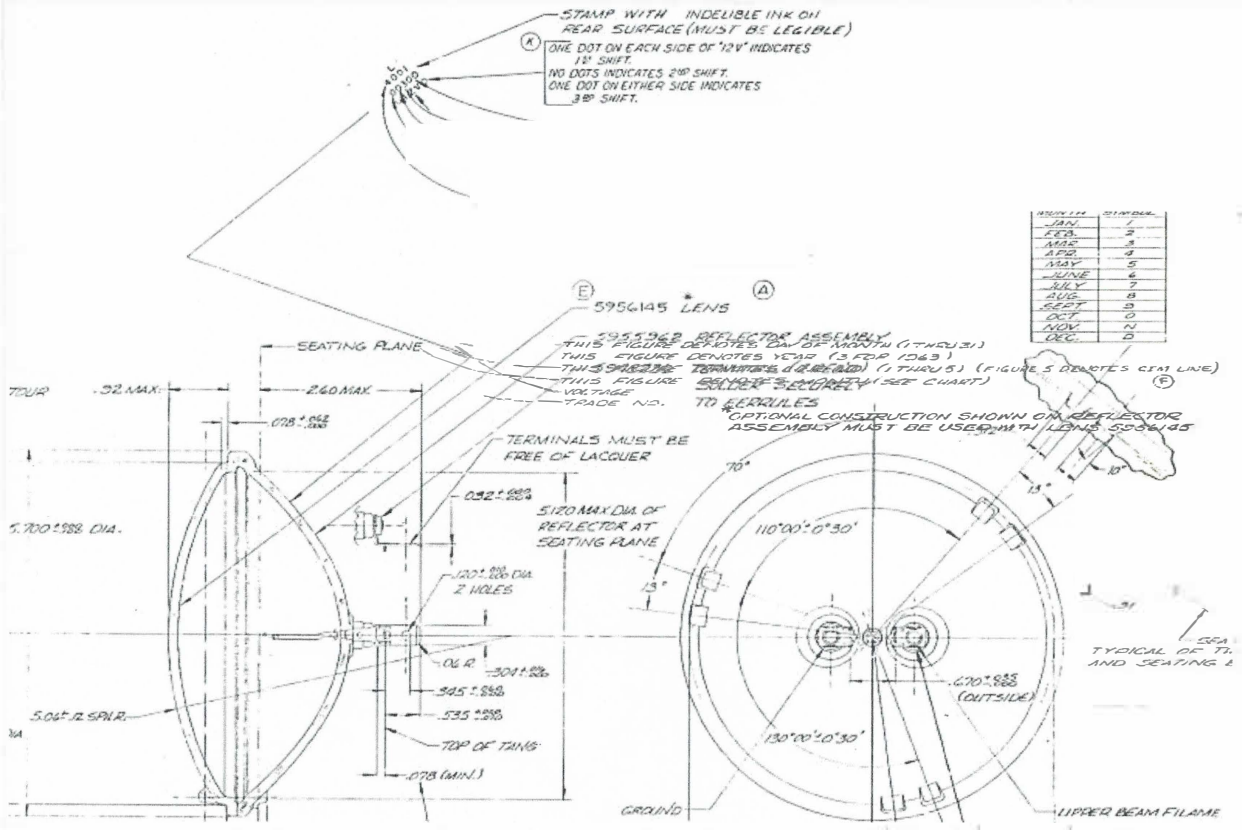




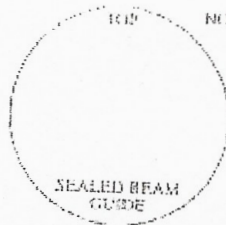
1997-2004 1 Lens 2 bulbs with Plastic lens
Has Guide upper inside area



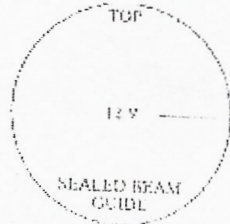
